On Monday February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 the Metairie Substance Addiction Ministry (SAM) group will be hosting a Resource and Information fair night at the St. Angela Merici Catholic Church Gymnasium, 901 Beverly Garden Dr, Metairie, La. at 7pm.

The SAM group is a parish-based ministry that offers help, healing, and hope, and support, to those afflicted with or affected by alcohol or drugs through Education, Prevention, Support, and Referrals.

This information night is for those members of the community who are seeking help and information about addiction. It is open to everyone of all faiths, especially those who are having issues with alcohol or drug use as well as those who have been affected by someone else's alcohol or drug use.

This information night will have Speakers from AA, Al-anon, and Catholic Charities as well as counselors, therapists, and professionals in the field of addiction. In addition, there will be representatives from many of the local addiction treatment facilities present to meet and answer questions. They will be there to offer information, as well as help, healing, and hope to those with questions about substance abuse and addiction.

Brochures and other resources will also be available from the numerous professionals who will be assembled for this night of resource information, to introduce themselves, and explain what services that they provide. The intention is to get the people who are seeking help with substance addiction in the same room with the professionals that can offer the help.
